PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

To the Honorable the United States District Court of the Southern District of New York in and for the Southern District of New York County of New York

The petition of Jerome Posner hereby filed, respectfully sheweth

First. My place of residence is New York City, New York (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)

Second. My occupation is None

Third. I was born on the 17th day of July anno Domini 1912 at New York City, New York

Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from France on or about the 1st day of July anno Domini 1912 and arrived in the United States, at the port of New York on the 7th day of July anno Domini 1912 on the vessel None (If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or mode of transportation company should be given.)

Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 7th day of July anno Domini 1912 at New York City, New York in the Supreme Court of New York and in the State of New York

I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to None of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 7th day of July anno Domini 1912 and in the State of New York continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 7th day of July anno Domini 1912, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the None Court of None on the None day of None anno Domini None and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit: None and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Therefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
